# JUNIOR CHECKLIST for College Readiness

Take the PSAT on Oct. 16, 2019. Study with the PSAT study guide. The junior PSAT is connected to
the National Merit Competition and it is also used as a measure for College Readiness, so it is
IMPORTANT TO DO YOUR BEST ON THE PSAT. Our District pays for all AISD students 9th -11th
and there is no need to pre-register.

Take the SAT/ACT at least once during the **spring of Junior year**. We anticipate that on Wed., March 4<sup>th</sup>, ALL AISD 11th graders will take the SAT School Day test administration at their HS campus.

help paying for the SAT and/or ACT? e College Advisor/College Center at your school; you may qualify for a FEE WAIVER.
Ensure you are enrolled in the most <b>rigorous coursework</b> possible and that you are <b>doing your BEST!</b> Keep in mind that the <b>GPA</b> (which drives your rank) that you will use for applying to college is calculated from all <b>coursework taken 9<sup>th</sup> -11<sup>th</sup> grade</b> (even HS credits taken in 7 <sup>th</sup> and 8 <sup>th</sup> grade).
<b>SAT and ACT Prep is important.</b> Practice SAT and ACT questions on-line at <a href="www.number2.com">www.number2.com</a> . Other free websites that offer SAT/ACT Prep online are <a href="www.sat.collegeboard.org">www.sat.collegeboard.org</a> , ACT <a href="www.actstudent.org">www.actstudent.org</a> , or <a href="https://www.khanacademy.org/test-prep/sats">https://www.khanacademy.org/test-prep/sats</a> . Sign up for the SAT question of the day at <a href="www.collegeboard.org">www.collegeboard.org</a> .
Talk to your counselor about your College Readiness based on your SAT, ACT, TSI and other test scores.
Work on Community Service to boost your resume. Get involved in clubs, activities (keep a log/resume).
Research colleges and universities. Try to visit colleges and have a solid list of your top four choices by the summer of your senior year. Also, <a href="www.student.naviance.com">utilize www.student.naviance.com</a> to work on the Application Planner, college searches, etc. This is a great program to help students track college applications and scholarships, create resumes, and help them keep up with the college application process.
<b>Get to know your counselor</b> and <b>college advisor</b> well. They will be invaluable during the college application process. Make an appointment to go over your transcript and your college plans. Visit the College & Career Center often!
Get close to your <b>junior teachers</b> . You may need them for Letters of Recommendation early next year.
Visit potential colleges and ask lots of questions. Use a College Visit form to be cleared with_attendance.  Juniors are allowed 2 visits and seniors are allowed 2 visits with the form turned in before the visit and

verification of attendance after the visit. See your college advisor for more information.
